MARIO MOSCA - Vocals

Born in Naples, Mario Mosca is a classic hard rock singer, whose matrix is attributable to the rock of the fathers of the genre, such as Deep Purple, Rainbow, Whitesnake.

He made his first steps into the world of music in 1994, when, at the age of 17, he set up his first band with some friends from school, forming TIXOTROPIA.

With this band, he obtained the first important awards, thanks to an EP "Killing the pig's Killer", which was a great success on a national level.

He then moved on to the prog band "Silent Field" in 1997, with which he released two albums distributed by Nocturnal Music.

In 2001 he joined the hard rock band "Larsen"

In 2010 with acoustic formations (Black Sheep), and then cblues (Bulldogs).

In 2015 he was hired by Lizhard, who identified Mario as the ideal voice to follow up on their successful record debut.

This collaboration leads to the album "Bigger, Better, Stronger" distributed by the American Perris Records, receiving enthusiastic acclaim.

In 2017 he was hired by the tribute band Iron Maiden, called Prodigal Sons, to replace the outgoing frontman

Since March 2020 he has also collaborated with the Starlight Italian Nightwish Tribute alongside the front woman.
